





Topic 1: Plastic Pollution & Marine Litter	Sub-Topic 1.1: Marine litter monitoring and management Sub-Topic 1.2: Addressing single-use plastics	Taking action to move away from single-use plastics in the Mediterranean To support the PCs in the development or improvement of National Plastic Management Strategies including e.g. ban of plastic bags and other single-use plastics. Deliverables may include: (a) Guidelines on measures to phase out single use plastic items; (b) capacity building for the public sector including Parliamentarians and high-level administrators as well as CSOs and producer/trade/user organisations. Coordination and synergies with Switch-Med and other relevant regional projects working on various aspects of the plastics challenge and processes will be carefully monitored.

Topic 1: Plastic Pollution & Marine Litter	Sub-Topic 1.1: Marine litter monitoring and management Sub-Topic 1.2: Addressing single-use plastics	Understanding better microplastics and identifying how to address the issue The capacity building activity will address mainly policy makers and will aim at giving them an overview of the different aspects of the microplastics issue (from the ones intentionally added in the production processes and products to the ones generated by the fragmentation and deterioration of plastics) and specific solutions that could be of relevance to the PCs. Technical assistance to address microplastics will be provided through a user friendly publication. Overlaps and synergies with SwitchMed, Plastic Busters and other regional projects and processes will be ensured and carefully monitored. A brief user-friendly publication will be produced targeting policy makers who have an important role to play in order to enable that shift. In addition, successful experiences should be disseminated to encourage others to act. This activity will be coordinated/co-organised with Switch-Med. 

Topic 2: Circular Economy	Sub-Topic 2.2: Waste management schemes and streams	Management of Construction & Demolition Waste (C&DW) (and Waste from Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE)) This regional activity takes up from the groundwork achieved by SWIM-H2020 SM and aims to support the PCs in the implementation of tools to monitor and classify C&DW (and WEEE). This regional capacity building activity will analyse opportunities to locally valorise the materials (circular economy approach), effectively engaging the local stakeholders, using PPPs, etc. A short user-friendly publication will be produced on the tools, targeting policy makers who have a role in enabling the changes.

It will address Ministries of Education, Environment, Water, Development, agencies and organisations of educators, as well as relevant CSOs/NGOs. Through this (ToT) activity a large number of educators of primary and secondary schools in the PCs will be indirectly reached. It directly supports the UfM SCP efforts in the region and will therefore be planned together with the UfM.



A brief user-friendly publication will be produced on the valorisation and marketing of compost from organic and agricultural waste.



It is proposed to start with an analysis of the sources of plastic pollution and then development an action plan that involves the different stakeholders. It is proposed to expand the activity to include different industries (including but not only plastics). Some manufacturers have shown their predisposition to finance remediation actions.
