Environmental Pollution and Unsustainable Consumption & Production Models

- Most products and services are provided by the private sector. Private businesses therefore play a pivotal
 role in society's shift towards Sustainable Consumption and Production (SCP).
- Policymakers need to create a level playing field, encourage and incentivize companies to take action.
- The shift to sustainable patterns of consumption and production that is urgently needed can be enabled only by pursuing a set of Sustainable Business models, based on circularity principles and eco-innovation approaches.


