Why Promoting Circular Economy Business Models?

- Biodiversity loss. The sixth mass extinction as a result of human activities such as resources extraction and processing
- Waste and emissions beyond nature's absorption capacities
- Climate change
- Water scarcity
- Unsustainable use of resources coupled with rising social inequalities
- → Urgent shift towards sustainability in needed.

Sustainable Consumption and Production and **Circular Economy** as major global approaches.






Circular Economy



Circular Economy is "one that produces no waste and pollution, by design or intention, and in which material flows are of two types, biological nutrients, designed to reenter the biosphere safely, and technical nutrients, which are designed to circulate at high quality in the production system without entering the biosphere as well as being restorative and regenerative by design." (Ellen MacArthur Foundation, 2013)

Circular Economy is based on three principles: Design out waste and pollution; Keep products and materials in use; Regenerate natural systems" (Ellen MacArthur Foundation)







What is a Sustainable/Circular Business?



Brief definition:

A sustainable business provides commercial solutions which create ecological value and/or safeguard the environment (addressing environmental challenges and/or reducing environmental impacts) and are economically viable and socially empowering.

Comprehensive definition:

Based on the interdependency between the environment, society and economy, a sustainable business provides innovative viable products and services contributing to green, circular, socially inclusive, carbon-neutral and toxic-free economies by:

- creating ecological value and/or safeguarding biodiversity and natural regeneration cycles (addressing environmental challenges, including climate change and/or reducing environmental impacts), as well as social value (addressing social needs), and
- by applying eco-innovation, life cycle thinking (including eco-design) and system thinking approaches.

Ecoinnovation



Ecoinnovation consists in providing new and alternative solutions, which allow a company to reduce its environmental impacts and/or create environmental value.








Ecodesign



Ecodesign consists in taking into account and assess from the design stage (of a product or service and its business model) any potential environmental impact. Impacts on the environment have to be systematically evaluated at all stages of the lifecycle of the product/service: design; extraction and purchasing of raw materials; production; packaging and distribution; sales and marketing, product use; end of life management.

In addition to reducing their environmental impacts and achieve their environmental goals, Ecodesign can bring added value to the companies:


- Increase company resilience, e.g. mitigate risks from resource and energy scarcity
