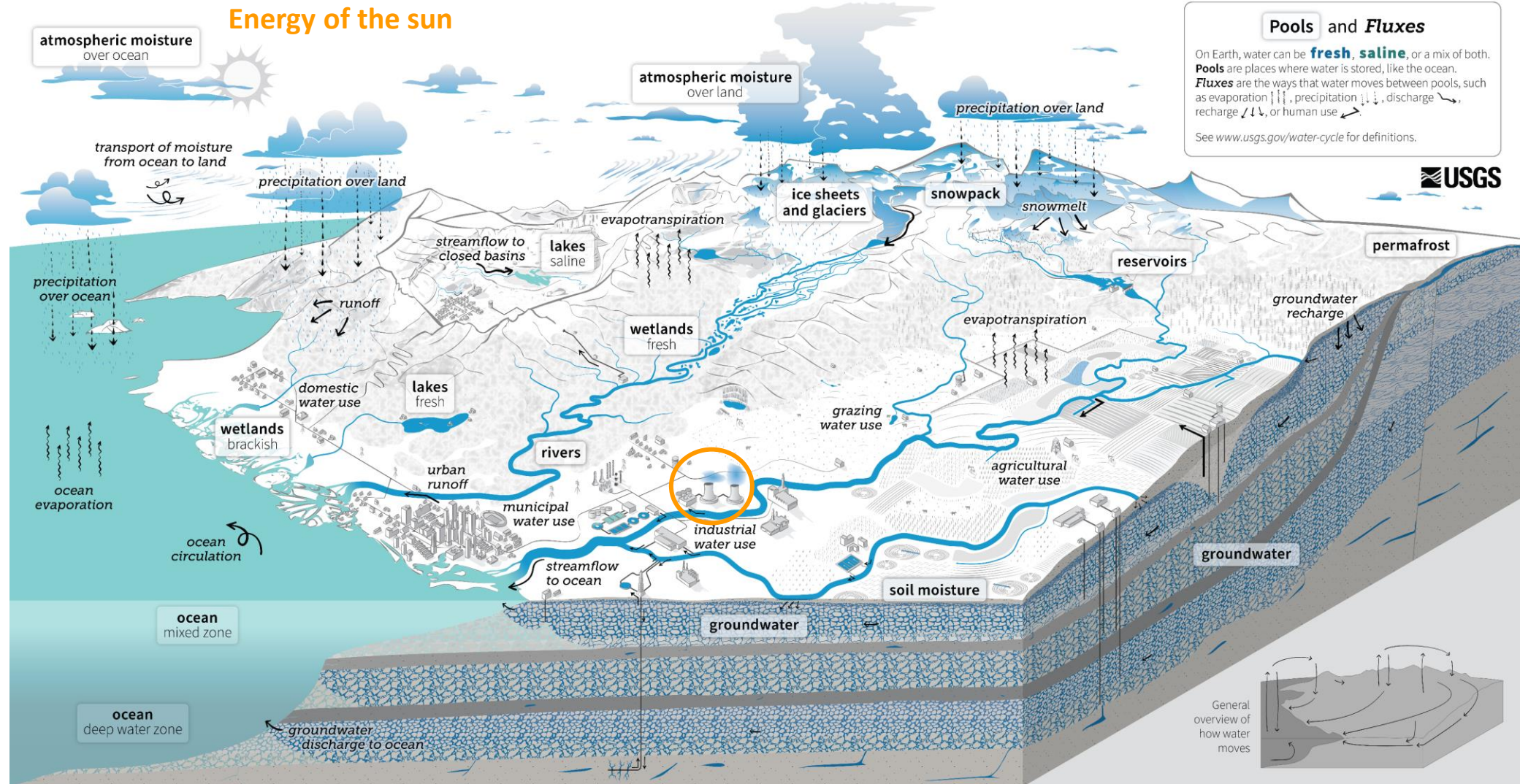

Facilitate

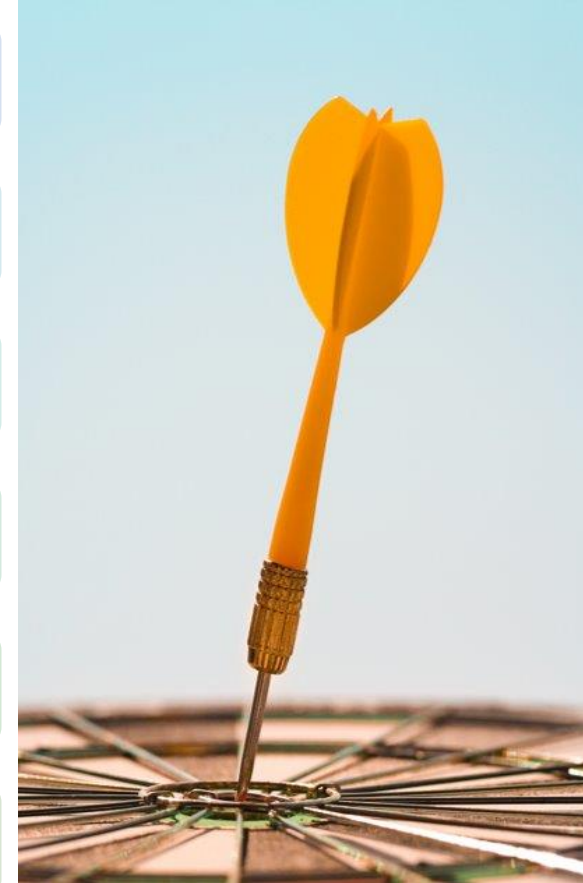
- Facilitate the identification, testing, dissemination and replication of Nexus solutions in the Mediterranean

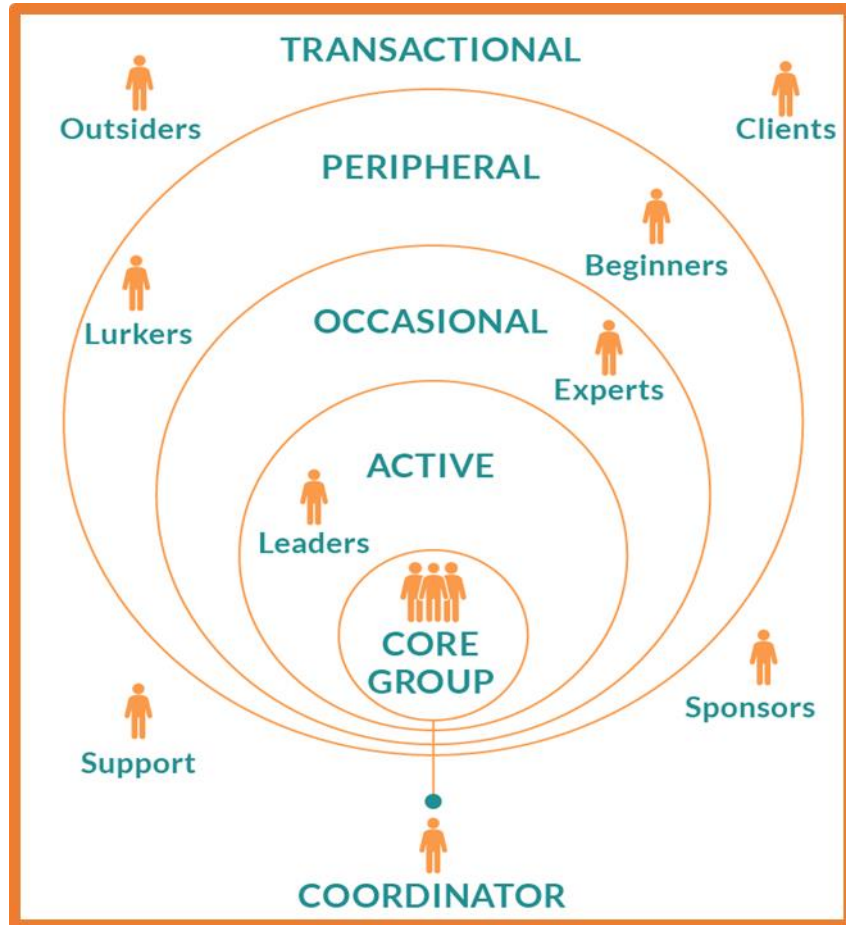
A group of people who engage in a process of collective **learning** in a shared domain: the WEFE Nexus!

Members engage in joint activities and discussions, help each other, and share **knowledge** and information.

Members are **practitioners**: they develop a shared collection of resources: experiences, examples, stories, tools and solutions to problems.

A CoP **connects** people who might otherwise not have the opportunity to interact.

Who are the members?



Core team: organize, nurture and operate the community

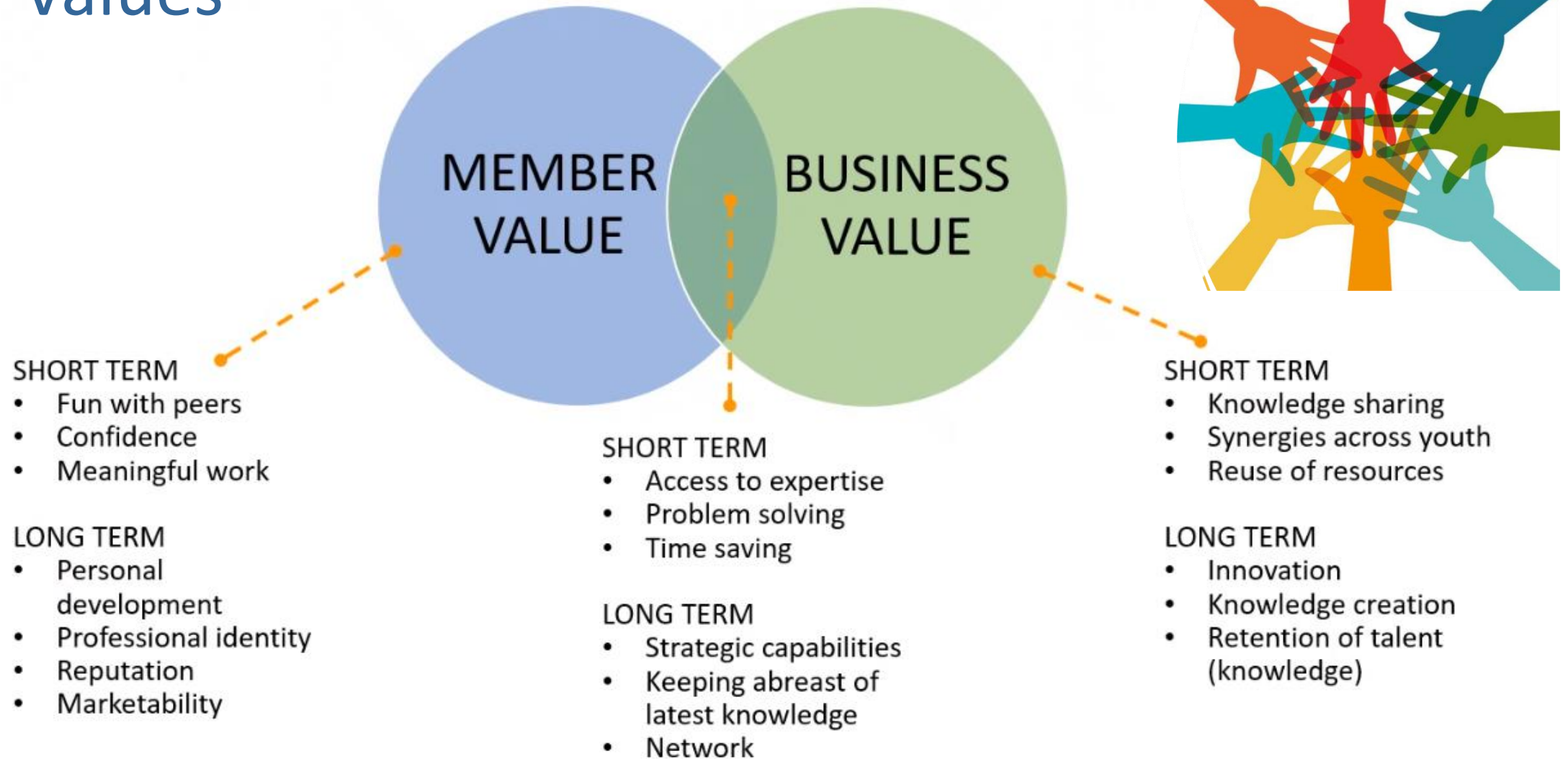
Active: help shape and direct the CoP

Occasional: participate on selected topics

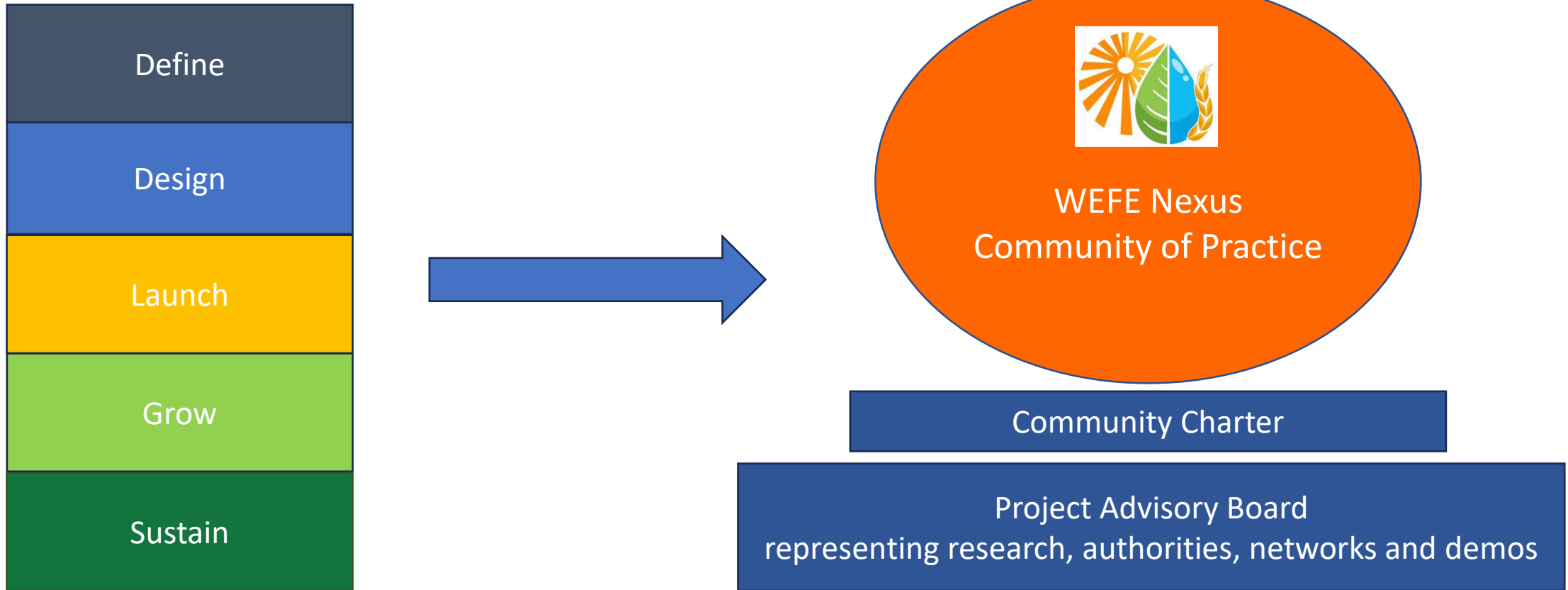
Peripheral: they feel connected, but engage only occasionally

Stimulate collaboration, further adoption and uptake of Nexus solutions at all levels

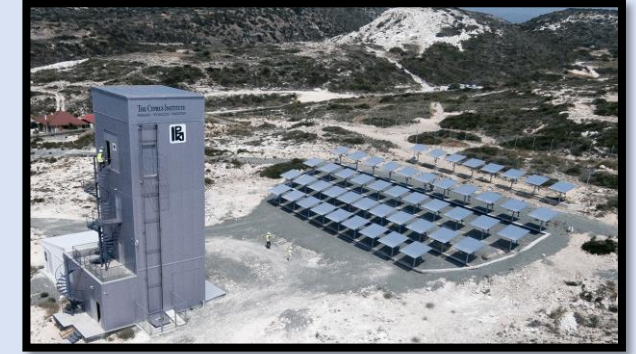
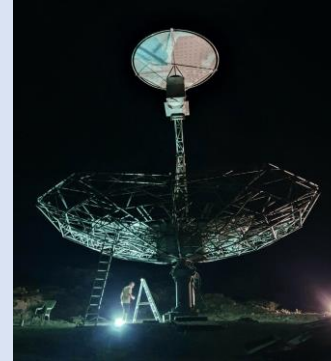
Nexus Demonstrators



1. Cyprus: PROTEAS Facility



An in-house design for testing solar technologies in realistic coastal-island conditions and synergizing electricity production with solar desalination.



2. Lebanon: Regen-R8



Blending cutting edge technologies with traditional farming. An AI-enabled platform for on-demand renewable energy that empowers farmers to implement efficient sustainable agriculture practices.

3. Malta: National Water Conservation Campaign - Water Be The Change



Delivering an effective educational and awareness raising campaign on the optimized and efficient use of water resources to facilitate a cultural shift in people's behavior towards water conservation on the Maltese Islands.



4. Jordan: Technical Solutions for Sustainable Agriculture



An applied WEFE Nexus technical intervention reusing treated wastewater for irrigation in three farms, after its tertiary treatment through constructed wetlands, with solar energy and climate-resilient planting.
